The Judicial Proceedings since Fiscal Year 2012 Amendments Panel (JPP) members greatly appreciate the Navy's responses to the JPP's previous requests for information (RFIs), your on-going cooperation to gather case data, and the superb presenters you have provided at our monthly public meetings. We are mindful that our requests put additional pressure on your personnel and resources. However, to accomplish our statutory tasks, we need to continue to ask for your assistance.

Over the next few months, the JPP will be examining issues related to retaliation against those who file sexual assault reports. To facilitate our understanding of the topic, we will need information regarding regulations, policies, procedures, and data maintained by the Navy. We request that you provide that information in responses to the attached document, *JPP RFI Set # 3*, by May 6, 2015. This will allow us time to review the Services' written answers and prepare for the May meeting.
