Thank you for the tremendous support you have given to the Judicial Proceedings since Fiscal Year 2012 Amendments Panel (JPP). The Army's responses to previous JPP requests for information (RFIs) have provided us with critical data and enhanced our awareness of the Army's efforts to address the issues surrounding sexual assault in the military.

Over the next two months, the JPP hopes to complete its initial review of the issues related to retaliation against those who file sexual assault reports. To aid our understanding of this complex topic, we need additional information regarding regulations, policies, procedures, and data maintained by the Army.
