| A military member alleged receiving letters of reprimand and a poor officer performance report in reprisal for filing an IG complaint providing testimony against her wing for not reporting or acting upon an incident involving sexual assault.   | 5/29/2013         | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Dismissed; complainant attempted to re-file a complaint that had already been dismissed but did not provide any new or compelling evidence requiring additional investigation into her case. | 8/21/2013          |
| A military member alleged he was removed from a promotion list and an award was rescinded in reprisal for reporting several sexual assaults that occurred within the unit.  | 8/21/2013         | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Dismissed; untimely complaint  | 8/28/2013          |

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| A military member alleged that her commander revoked her deployment orders, gave her a letter of reprimand, and moved her to another location on a temporary basis in reprisal for reporting sexual assault.  | 9/9/2013          | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Dismissed; complainant did not cooperate with investigation  | 11/4/2013          |
| A military member alleged that his former and new commanding officers possibly restricted him from making or preparing a lawful protected communication and that the commanders possibly took personnel actions against him in reprisal for making protected communications to the command's Sexual Assault Reponse Coordinator and Unit Victim Advocate. | 7/17/2013         | DoD IG             | Marine Corps        | 8/2/2013            | Not Substantiated  | 1/7/2014           |
| A military member alleged she received a negative counseling statement, failed to receive an award, and received a poor officer evaluation report in reprisal for reporting that she was sexually assaulted by another military member.   | 4/10/2013         | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Pending Investigation  |                    |
| A military member who was a third party filed a complaint on a reprisal form that alleged that another military member had been sexually assaulted by a military member.  | 11/15/2013        | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Declined; no specific allegation of reprisal; the underlying matter was referred to NCIS as a possible criminal matter | 11/25/2013         |
| A military member alleged his commanding officer took him to Captain's Mast, gave him a punitive Letter of Reprimand and an adverse FITREP in reprisal for reporting a sexual assault.  | 12/4/2013         | DoD IG             | Navy                | 12/17/2013          | Pending Investigation  |                    |
| A military member alleged threatened or possible unfavorable personnel action and being moved from workplace in reprisal for reporting sexual assault and other matters.  | 12/15/2013        | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Dismissed; complainant did not respond to requests for clarification.  | 2/20/2014          |

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| A member of the Coast Guard alleged he was criminally investigated and suffered numerous unfavorable personnel actions in reprisal for reporting an alleged sexual assault or other potentially unlawful sexual contact by one of his crewmembers upon another. Additionally, after his termination the commanding officer held a meeting with his subordinates and publicly humiliated and discredit the member's professional reputation.  | 2/25/2014         | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Declined; when the Coast Guard is not operating as a service of the Navy, MWPA complaints are handled by DHS. The DHS Whistleblower Protection Ombudsman verified that DHS IG had received the complaint was handling it. | 3/6/2014           |
| A military member alleged that he was moved at work and given a computer or phone in reprisal for reporting fraud, waste, or abuse and then subsequently reporting that his supervisor sexually assaulted someone.   | 4/7/2014          | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Declined; duplicate of a case being investigated by the Air Force   | 4/9/2014           |
| A military member alleged that he reported a sexual assault 5 years ago and as a result he was poisoned and his home was broken into. He reported this to NCIS but claims nothing was done.  | 4/21/2014         | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Declined; criminal acts, not personnel actions under the MWPA   | 4/28/2014          |
| A military member alleged that she was denied active duty orders, training, promotion, 2 week annual tour, transfer, and subjected to significant change to duties, responsibilities, and working conditions and constructive transfer to the National Guard in reprisal for reporting a drugging and potential sexual assault.  | 5/19/2014         | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Pending Investigation   |                    |
| A military member alleged that he was told if he spoke of it to anyone that he would be brought up on charges, was investigated by the command for inappropriate action so the command could pull his promotion and ruin his career in the military in reprisal for reporting a sexual assault. He was removed from theater, flagged "every way possible," had his security clearance suspended, and was removed from active duty while on medical hold while still having medical issues. | 9/24/2014         | DoD IG             |                     |                     | Declined; untimely (events occurred in 2011) and there is no unfavorable personnel action under DoD Directive 7050.06   | 9/25/2014          |
