

- Represent you in interviews, hearings, & military trials


Independent

- Special Victims' Counsels have an independent chain of command in Washington, DC



Types of Reports

⇒ Restricted Reporting

- Enables you to make a report of sexual assault without triggering a investigation.
- Allows access to medical care, counseling, victim advocate, Special Victims' Counsel, and additional resources.

⇒ Unrestricted Reporting

- The SARC, command, and OSI will be notified and an investigation will be initiated.
- Allows access to medical care, counseling, a victim advocate, Special Victims' Counsel, and additional resources.

Guidelines for Reports

⇒ To make a Restricted report, you may **ONLY** contact the following:

- Victim Advocate
- Healthcare personnel
- Special Victims' Counsel

⇒ To make an Unrestricted Report, you may contact:
