**The Nineteenth Public Meeting of the Judicial Proceedings Panel will be held on Friday, March 11, 2016 in Arlington, Virginia.**

Arlington, VA - The nineteenth public meeting of the Judicial Proceedings Panel (“JPP” or “the Panel”) will be held on Friday, March 11, 2016, from 9:30 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. at The Holiday Inn Arlington at Ballston, 4610 N. Fairfax Drive, Arlington, Virginia 22203.

The Judicial Proceedings Panel was established by the Secretary of Defense in June 2014 in accordance with section 576(a)(2) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2013. The Judicial Proceedings Panel is an independent federal advisory committee tasked to conduct an independent review and assessment of military judicial proceedings for sexual assault offenses since Fiscal Year 2012, for the purpose of developing recommendations to Congress and the Secretary of Defense for improvements to such proceedings.

At this meeting, the Panel members will analyze military sexual assault case data from fiscal years 2012-2014, and conduct deliberations on the adjudication of those offenses, to develop recommendations for the Secretary of Defense and Congress. The meeting will conclude with time reserved for public comment.

The Panel welcomes input from the public on topics of this meeting or other issues considered by the Panel.
