Arlington, VA – As previously announced, the twenty-third public meeting of the Judicial Proceedings Panel (“JPP” or “the Panel”) will be held on Friday, October 14, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Executive Conference Center, 14th floor, One Liberty Center, 875 North Randolph Street, Arlington, Virginia 22203.

Please note the following presenter changes for the meeting: Professor Stephen Saltzburg, the Wallace and Beverley Woodbury University Professor of Law at The George Washington University Law School, originally scheduled to present on victims’ appellate rights, is no longer able to attend; Mr. Christopher M. Johnson, Chief Appellate Defender for the state of New Hampshire, will now be participating in the victims’ appellate rights session by telephone.

This meeting is open to the public.
