II. Victim’s Right of Access to Information

Victim’s Right to Access Information: Review and clarify the extent of a victim’s right to access information that is relevant to the assertion of a particular right. (*RSP Recommendation 45*).

13. DoD: Provide the draft Executive Order specifying information a sexual assault victim would be entitled to receive from the filing of a report through the military justice process and detailed procedures for victims to receive such information.

DoD	There is no draft Executive Order that matches the description of that provided by RFI 13. However, the Department anticipates that the upcoming revision of Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 1030.02, “Victim and Witness Assistance,” discussed more fully in the response to RFI 19, below, will include a section concerning information to be provided to crime victims.
