

**JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS PANEL

**31. Services: Have counsel from your Service received SVC training from another Service? If so, how many?**

<b>USA</b>	Eight Active Duty and Reserve Component SVCs attended the May 2014 Air Force Special Victims' Counsel Course at Maxwell AFB, Alabama.
<b>USAF</b>	AF SVCs have not yet attended a training course from another Service to receive training. However, SVCs have provided training at two Army courses at The Judge Advocate General's Legal Center and School (TJAGLCS) in October 2013 and August 2014. They have presented "Lessons Learned as a SVC" and participated in break-out sessions involving mock client interviews.
<b>USN</b>	Yes, two Navy VLC received VLC/SVC training from the Army and 20 received training from the Air Force.
<b>USMC</b>	<p>Yes. Marine Corps VLCO personnel have attended SVC training offered by the Air Force, Army, and Navy, specifically:</p> <p>Air Force Judge Advocate General's School - Special Victims' Counsel Course (SVCC):  15-18 October 2013 – 16 attended.  19-23 May 2014 – 5 attended.  22-23 May 2014 – 5 attended (advanced course).</p> <p>The Judge Advocate General's Legal Center and School - Special Victims' Counsel Course:  18-22 August 2014 – 1 attended.</p> <p>Naval Justice School - Special Victims' Legal Counsel Course:  15-16 January 2014 – 4 attended.</p>
<b>USCG</b>	Of the Coast Guard SVCs who have attended SVC training, all have done so at one of the courses provided by the other services.
