41. DoD and Services: What metrics are currently tracked by DoD and each Service for the SVC Program? Who reviews SVC metrics, and how frequently are reviews conducted?

DoD	Response Pending
USA	The Army tracks the number of Active Component, Reserve and National Guard SVC, the number of victims who have received SVC assistance, the type of assistance provided, and courses provided. Monthly reports are compiled by SVC staff and reviewed by the SVC Program Manager and Chief of Legal Assistance Policy Division.
USAF	The SVC Program does not currently track any metrics for DoD. See RFI #40 regarding items that are tracked and provided to The Judge Advocate General for review and forwarding to the Secretary of the Air Force and Chief of Staff of the Air Force.
USN	Metrics collected are noted on enclosure (17). An additional metric of “VLC Travel Costs” is supplied by OJAG Code 64 (Fiscal and Resource Services) each week and included in the Program Report to CNLSC. ENCLOSURE 17: VLC Data Collection Template
USMC	The OIC, VLCO continuously tracks the below metrics using VLCO CMS.
