Subj: WITHHOLDING OF AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE CERTAIN TYPES OF PUNISHMENTS AT NONJUDICIAL PUNISHMENT PROCEEDINGS

Ref: (a) JAGINST 5800.7F (JAGMAN)
(b) 10 U.S.C. §815 (UCMJ, Art 15)
(c) Manual for Courts-Martial (2012 ed.)

1. Per paragraph 0106(e) of reference (a), Recruiting Station Commanding Officers within the Eastern Recruiting Region are hereby prohibited from imposing reduction in rank as a punishment at proceedings conducted pursuant to reference (b). The Recruiting Station Commanding Officer's authority to impose all other types of punishments authorized by the references remains unaffected by this decision.

2. Furthermore, any misconduct for which reduction in rank at non-judicial punishment or Relief for Cause (RFC) from recruiting duty may be appropriate must be referred to the District Commanding Officer for disposition.

Subj: COURT-MARTIAL CONVENING AUTHORITY

1. Purpose. To prescribe policy and guidance for convening of courts-martial for Marine Corps Installations Command (MCICOM) commands and other commands aboard, or provided legal services by Marine Corps Base, Quantico, VA (MCBQ).

2. Policy.

a. All general officers in command, or their immediate temporary successors, have the authority to convene general courts-martial under references (a) and (b) and to approve or process administrative separations under reference (c). Per references (d) and (e), except for members of Marine Corps Combat Development Command (MCCDC) and its subordinate commands, the Commander MCBQ shall, in the absence of other guidance or agreement, exercise general court-martial convening authority and administrative separation authority over all enlisted personnel assigned to Marine Corps units in the National Capital Region (NCR) for legal process by directive, memorandum, or other agreement.

b. Per reference (f), with the exception of MCCDC and its subordinate commands, the MCICOM Commanding General will dispose of all allegations of officer misconduct in NCR. Per reference (d), the Commanding General of MCCDC will serve as the alternate show cause authority on substantiated incidents of officer misconduct in the NCR. Likewise, the Commanding General of MCCDC will also serve as the appeal authority for cases of non-judicial punishment adjudicated by the Commanding General of MCICOM.


c. Pursuant to ref (d), MCICOM through the Joint Law Center, MCBQ, will continue to provide legal support to CG, MCCDC and other tenant units aboard MCBQ.

4. Action.

a. Activity heads will comply with the policy and guidance contained in this Order.

b. The Staff Judge Advocate shall initiate and monitor efforts to ensure all assignments of convening authority to Quantico and NCR commands conform to the policy and guidance contained in this order.

c. Comptroller shall ensure all Memoranda of Agreement and Intraservice Support Agreements reference this Order in any terms describing the provision of legal services involving courts-martial and administrative separations.

POLICY LETTER 07-14

Subj: WITHHOLDING OF AUTHORITY TO DISPOSE OF CASES INVOLVING OFFICERS
OR CASES INVOLVING MARINES OR SAILORS IN THE GRADE OF E-6 OR
HIGHER

Ref: (a) Article 22, U.C.M.J.
(b) R.C.M. 306, MCM (2012 ED.)
(c) JAGMAN 0106
(d) R.C.M. 401, MCM (2012 ED.)

1. Pursuant to references (a) - (c), I hereby withhold initial disposition authority from all commanders within Training Command (TRNGCMD) with respect to offenses committed by any commissioned officers or committed by any Marines or sailors who are in the grade of E-6 or higher. This withholding applies to all alleged offenses. Exceptions to this policy will be made on a case-by-case basis upon written request to the Commanding General, TRNGCMD via the Staff Judge Advocate, Training Command.

2. The effective date of this action will be the date signed. As the initial disposition authority, my action will be based upon review of the matter transmitted, any independent review and recommendation received, and consultation with the TRNGCMD Staff Judge Advocate. Pursuant to reference (d), subordinate commanders are encouraged to provide recommendations regarding disposition of cases to which this withholding policy applies.

3. Nothing in this policy removes the responsibility of commanders, at every level, to convene investigations pursuant to references (b) through (d) of all alleged offenses and to promote good order and discipline within their units in order to prevent future misconduct.
