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- H.V. v. Kitchen The Coast Guard Court of Criminal Appeals held that the scope of the psychotherapist-patient privilege under M.R.E. 513 extends to a therapist's mental health diagnoses and resulting treatment.
- Randolph v. H.V. and the United States The accused in H.V. v. Kitchen appealed the Coast Guard decision to the Court of Appeals of the Armed Forces (CAAF) seeking reinstatement of the trial judge's ruling ordering disclosure of the victim's mental health diagnosis and treatment. CAAF declined to hear this issue due to lack of jurisdiction.
